Richard Donaghey - Richard is a member of the Caddo Nation of Oklahoma and currently resides on the Navajo Reservation in Ft. Defiance, Arizona. Richard is an educational specialist who works in Gallup, New Mexico. Richard has been dancing and singing at pow-wows since the 1960s, and has been a champion in both the Northern Traditional and Southern Straight categories of dancing. His two children Kenny and Richelle are both pow-wow champions. He has traveled frequently to Western Europe and Holland on many occasions. Richard founded the First Nations Dance Company, he also speaks some of the Dutch language.

Kenny Donaghey - Kenny is a member of the Caddo and Navajo Nations. He resides in Crownpoint, New Mexico with his family. He has two children Colby and Grace, and they are both learning to dance. Kenny graduated from Crownpoint High School and participates in pow-wows across the USA and Canada. Kenny dances, sings, and dances at pow-wows, and is a champion in the men's Northern Traditional category. He has traveled to Western Europe several times and has been to Holland many times to perform at the Western Experience. He is also an original company member of First Nations Dance Company.

Richelle Donaghey - Richelle is a member of the Navajo and Caddo Nations. She resides in Ft. Defiance, Arizona on the Navajo Indian Reservation. Richelle enjoys sewing and going to pow-wows. She is a champion in the Teen Fancy Shawl category of dancing. She also dances the Jingle Dress dance. Currently she attends Window Rock High School and is to graduate May 2007. She lives with her parents Marlene Tsosie and Richard Donaghey. Richelle has traveled to various parts of Western Europe and has been to Holland many times.

Fernando Cellicion - Fernando is a member of the Zuni Nation, and he resides in Zuni Pueblo, New Mexico. He is well known throughout the world as a Native flutist. Fernando is also an excellent pow-wow singer and sings with the Zuni Southern Singers. Fernando has recorded many CDs and is currently working on a DVD of his flute music. Fernando has traveled to a number of places in the world including Europe, Asia, and the USA. Fernando has traveled to Holland many times and has numerous friends and acquaintances.



FLORENTINE JOHNSON

Florentine Johnson - Florentine is the Head Singer of the Zuni Southern Singers. He is also the Drum Keeper. Florentine is a member of the Zuni Nation, and he resides in Zuni Pueblo, New Mexico. Florentine is also an artist and produces silver-work and jewelry. He sings both contemporary pow-wow songs, and also sings traditional Zuni songs for the Eagle dance, Buffalo Dance, and others. Florentine has also traveled worldwide and has been to both Europe and Asia. Florentine is also well known for his humor. He has also traveled to Holland many times.

Mangaysha Kallestewa - Mangaysha is a member of the Zuni Nation and he resides in Zuni Pueblo, New Mexico. He is a singer with the Zuni Southern Singers and participates in pow-wows. Mangaysha is also a Zuni traditional dancer who performs a number of dances including the Eagle Dance, Buffalo Dance, Turkey Dance, as well as others. At home he is an artist and a cook, who enjoys being at home in Zuni. Mangaysha has traveled worldwide with both the Cellicion Traditional Dancers and the First Nations Dance Company. He has visited Holland many times.

SYLVIN NOCHE

Sylvin Noche - Sylvin is a member of the Zuni Nation, and resides in Zuni Pueblo, New Mexico. Sylvin is a multitasking person who sings pow-wow songs and is also a dancer of traditional Zuni dances. He dances the Eagle Dance, Buffalo Dance, Deer Dance, and others. He sings with the Zuni Southern Singers and dances with the Cellicion Traditional Dance group. Sylvin has visited many parts of the world and has performed with First Nations Dance Company on many occasions. He has visited Holland many times throughout the years.

Chance Sherman - Chance is a member of the Navajo Nation and resides in Twin Lakes, New Mexico. He is a champion in the men's Northern Traditional category of dance. Chance is a skilled artisan who creates dancing bustles, other forms of featherwork, and head roaches. He travels frequently to pow-wows across the USA and Canada and has become well known in the pow-wow circle. Chance has traveled many times to Western Europe and has been coming to Holland since the 1990s. Chance has been a featured performer of the First Nations Dance Company and Western Experience since 1996.

Dominic Largo - Dominic is a member of the Navajo Nation and is a Southern Fancy Dancer. Dominic is a champion in the teen category of dancing. He travels frequently to pow-wows across the American Southwest and sings with the Callin Eagle drum group. Dominic is 15 years old and is a sophomore at Bloomfield High School. He is from Lake Valley, New Mexico but, lives in Bloomfield with parents Jerald and Darlinda Largo. His hobbies are running, horse riding, fishing, bike trail riding and eating. But above all, he loves to dance and sing at powwows. This is Dominic's first time in the Netherlands.

Jared Brown - Jared is a member of both the Navajo and Paiute Nations. He currently resides in Sawmill, Arizona on the Navajo Indian Reservation. He currently attends Window Rock High School and enjoys playing basketball with his friends. Jared is a member of a Drum Group known as the "Callin Eagle" singers, they travel frequently to a variety of pow-wows in the American Southwest. Jared is a champion Northern Traditional dancer in the teen category of dancing. This is Jared's first time in the Netherlands.



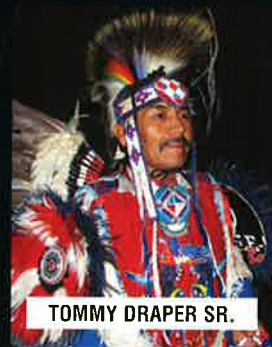

Wanda Brown - Wanda is a member of the Navajo and Paiute Nations. Wanda and her son Jared help form the basis of the "Callin Eagle" drum group, and they travel frequently to pow-wows in the USA. Wanda is also a teacher who works at Navajo Middle School, in Navajo, New Mexico. She currently just graduated with her Masters degree from New Mexico State University in educational administration. Wanda sings with her boys at pow-wows across the American Southwest. This is her first time to visit the Netherlands.

Tommy Draper Sr. - Tommy is a member of the Navajo Nation from Kirtland, New Mexico. He is a Fancy Dancer and Hoop Dancer. He has been dancing for over 40 years and has been a champion many times. Last year he was the Champion in the seniors category at the World Championship of Hoop Dancing at the Heard Museum in Phoenix, Arizona. Tommy lives with his wife Laura, and some grandchildren. Tommy has been to Holland many times in the past and is one of the original members of First Nations Dance Company.

Laura Draper - Laura is a member of the Navajo Nation. She is married to Tommy Draper, and they have a number of children including Tommy Jr. (Spike), Tyson, April, and Tierra. All of the children participate in pow-wows. Laura is a teacher in Kirtland and works with young children. She has been dancing in the women's Northern Traditional and participates in pow-wows often. Laura has been to Holland many times in the past and is one of the original members of the First Nations Dance Company.

Tierra Draper - Tierra is a member of the Navajo Nation, she is the daughter of Laura and Tommy Draper. Tierra is a champion in the Northern Traditional Cloth dress style of dancing in the teen category. She travels frequently with her family to pow-wows across the USA and Canada. Tierra attends Kirtland High School and enjoys being with her friends. Tierra has been to Holland many times in the past, and this is her first time back in the Netherlands since 2001.

Neal Thunderhawk - Neal is a member of both the Lakota and Navajo Nations. He resides in Shiprock, New Mexico, and works for the City of Farmington. Neal is a champion dancer in the men's Grass Dance category. He also dances the Chicken Dance and is a well known singer of pow-wow songs. He sings with various drum groups such as Native Boyz and Southern Outlawz. Neal has also traveled to a variety of places in the world and has been to Holland on several occasions. Neal participates in pow-wows across the USA and Canada.
